To discuss and consider how portraits give an insight into the person that they are portraying.	To create a 3D self-portrait using modelling clay.

To be able to name the seven continents and start to discuss some of the different features of each one.	To use world maps, atlases and globes in order to locate the seven continents and the five oceans.
To know some of the places that Florence Nightingale visited.	To be able to locate some of the places that Florence visited.
To learn the language relating to the 4 points of a compass. (North, South, East, West.)	To begin to use the 4 points of a compass in order to give directions.
