### History

Knowledge	Skills
To learn about aspects of the Ancient Egyptian way of life.	To consider/place the Ancient Egyptian civilisation within a wider framework of world history.
To learn about the Ancient Egyptian's beliefs relating to gods and the afterlife.	To demonstrate an understanding of the terms BC and AD when placing events in chronological order.
To learn about Howard Carter and the discovery of Tutankhamun's tomb.	To be able to use artefacts in order to deduce information about the Ancient Egyptians.

### Art

Knowledge	Skills
To develop an appreciation of artwork and artefacts created during this period.	To sketch an Egyptian death mask, applying different techniques in order to add detail.
To develop an awareness of how artists, designers and craft workers, from the Ancient Egyptian culture, developed, expressed and represented their ideas.	To create an Egyptian death mask using mod-roc.
	To combine paint and other materials in order to effectively create detail and add texture to my death mask.

### Geography

Knowledge	Skills
To understand where Egypt is in relation to other countries.	To be able to locate Egypt on a map or globe.
To know why the River Nile was so important to the Ancient Egyptians.	Use primary and secondary sources to find out information about the River Nile.
To learn about rivers.	To conduct a river survey.

### Design Technology

Knowledge	Skills
To explore how the Ancient Egyptians would have transported water using a shaduf.	To construct a simple pulley using rope over a horizontal bar to raise an object off the ground.
To explore how a shaduf worked.	To design, plan and make a working shaduf.
To understand why the shaduf was so important to the Ancient Egyptians.	To evaluate the success of their shaduf 'prototype' discussing any areas for improvement.
