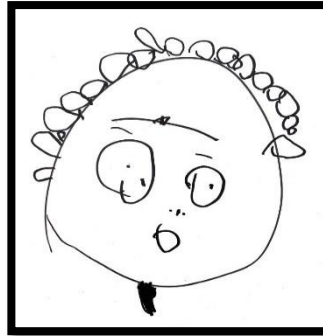

<p><b>Starting Nursery</b>-Learning names, teacher names, greetings, Talk about summer holidays, naming different experiences.</p> <p>To know I have changed since I was a baby, to describe humans at different ages/life stages. We will look at baby photos and how we have changed. We may have a visit from a baby and see how their needs are different to ours.</p> <p>I know how I look after myself and can compare this to how a baby is looked after. We will learn how to brush our teeth correctly, take home teeth brushing packs and demonstrate some skills we can achieve now we have grown e.g. putting on coats, shoes. We will learn how to wash our hands correctly.</p>	<p>I know how to use my senses to compare smells, sounds, tastes and textures. I will taste different food during international week and explore with smells and textures in our nursery garden and in our nursery e.g. (feathers, pine cones, sticks etc.)</p>	<p><b>All About Me</b>-Learning about appearances, talking about hair colour, skin colour, eye colour, similarities and differences.
